Exposition Competition/Rules

1. Purpose

The objective of *The Security Network (TSN)* is to further *TSN* objectives by providing a forum through exhibits, a technical competition education and networking. Exhibitors/Competitors are limited to firms, organizations and agencies whose exhibits are in harmony with the purpose of this Exposition/Competition and conference. Active selling or order taking is NOT permitted.

2. Location of Exposition

The Exposition & Competition will be held at the McMillin Companies Event Center Main Hall, San Diego, California within the spaces that *TSN* assigns for this purpose. These assignments shall be made in the discretion of *TSN* as to location, size and configuration. The configuration proposed by each Exhibitor/Competitor must be approved in advance by *TSN*. Special requirements for power, lighting, audio/video or other matters (which shall be permitted only to the extent approved by *TSN*) should be itemized by the Exhibitor/Competitor and approved in advance by *TSN*. Access and use shall be limited to the times the Exposition/Competition is being held and may be limited by *TSN* so as not to conflict with competitions or presentations.

3. Subleasing

Exhibitor/Competitors may not sublet their exhibit space, nor any part thereof, nor exhibit, offer for sale, or advertise articles not manufactured or sold by the exhibiting company, except where such articles are necessary for proper demonstration or operation of the exhibitor's display, in which case identification shall be limited to the manufacturer's normal regular nameplate. An Exhibitor/Competitor may not permit non-exhibiting company representatives to operate from its booth. Rulings of *TSN* shall, in all instances, be final with regard to use of exhibit space.

4. Occupancy Default

Any exhibitor/competitor failing to occupy space contracted for shall not be relieved of the obligation of paying the full rental charge of such space. If not occupied by the time set for completion of the installation of the displays, such space shall be taken by *TSN*, and re-allocated or reassigned for such purposes or use *TSN* may see fit.

5. Eligibility

TSN has the sole right to determine the eligibility of any company or product for inclusion in the Exposition.

6. Cancellation or Change of Exposition

In the event that the premises in which the Exposition/Competition is conducted should become unfit for occupancy or substantially interfered with by reason of any cause or causes not reasonably within the control of *TSN* or its agents, the Exposition/Competition may be canceled or moved to another appropriate location, at the sole discretion of *TSN*. *TSN* shall not be responsible for delays, damage, loss, increased costs, or other unfavorable conditions arising by virtue of cause or causes not reasonably within the control of *TSN*. Causes for such action beyond the control of *TSN* shall include, but are not limited to: fire, casualty, flood, epidemic, earthquake, explosion, accident, blockage, embargo, inclement weather, governmental restraints, act of a public enemy, riot or civil disturbance, impairment or lack of adequate transportation, inability to secure sufficient labor, technical or other personnel, labor union disputes, loss of lease or other termination by the NTC Promenade, municipal, state or federal laws, or act of God. Should *TSN* terminate this agreement pursuant to the provisions of this section, the exhibitor waives claims for damage arising therefrom. Refunds of "Paid Exhibit/Competition Space Fees" in the event of event termination or cancellation shall be made to exhibitors at the sole discretion of *TSN* and in any case, will not exceed the amount of each exhibitor's paid exhibit space fee less any pro rata adjustments based on non-reimbursable direct and/or indirect event costs or financial obligations incurred by *TSN* through the date of exhibitors' notification of event termination or cancellation or through the completion of event termination or cancellation processes, whichever is later.

7. Cancellation by Exhibitor/Competitor

In the event of cancellation by an exhibitor, *TSN* shall be entitled to assess 100% of total rental space fee or any percentage thereof at the sole discretion of *TSN*. *TSN* must receive written notification of the cancellation by registered or certified mail. The date cancellation notice is received by *TSN* will determine above assessment charges. In the event of either a full or partial cancellation of space by an exhibitor, *TSN* reserves the right to reassign canceled space, regardless of the cancellation assessment. Subsequent reassignment of canceled space does not relieve the canceling exhibitor of the obligation to pay the cancellation assessment. Appropriate payment must be received within 15 days of cancellation.

8. Limitation of Liability

Exhibitor/Competitor agrees to make no claim for any reason whatsoever against *TSN* for loss, theft, damage, or destruction of goods; nor for any injury, including death, to himself, employees, agents or representatives; nor for any damage of any nature, including damage to his business for failure to provide exhibit space; nor for failure to hold the Exposition/Competition as scheduled; nor for any action or omission of *TSN*. The exhibitor/competitor is solely responsible for his own exhibition material and products, and should insure exhibit and products from loss or damage from any cause whatsoever. It is understood all property of an exhibitor is in his care, custody, and control in transit to, or from, or within the confines of the exhibit hall. *TSN* shall bear no responsibility for the safety of the exhibitor, its personnel, employees, agents or representatives or personal property.

9. Insurance

Exhibitors/Competitors shall, at their sole cost and expense, procure and maintain through the term of this contract, the following insurance: Comprehensive General Liability insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000 including Contractual Liability and Products Liability coverage and Workman's Compensation in full compliance with all laws covering the exhibitor employees. *TSN* shall be named as an additional insured on all such policies. Proof of such insurance shall be provided to *TSN* or its agent or representative upon request.

10. Installing, Exhibiting, Competing, Dismantling

Hours and dates for installing, exhibiting, competing and dismantling shall be those specified by *TSN*. Exhibitor shall be liable for all storage and handling charges resulting from failure to remove exhibit material from the Exposition/Competition before the specified conclusion of the dismantling period set by *TSN*.

11. Damage to Property

Exhibitor/Competitor may not apply paint, lacquer, adhesive or other coatings to building columns, floors or walls, hanging anything from the ceiling, fixtures or exhibits or to table top space equipment.

12. Floor Loading

Under no circumstances may the weight of any equipment or exhibit material exceed the specified floor load limit of the exhibit/competition space. Exhibitor/Competitor accepts full and sole responsibility for injury or damage to property or persons resulting from failure, knowingly or otherwise, to distribute the exhibit/competition material and products in conformity with the maximum floor load specifications.

13. Alcoholic Beverages

The dispensing, distribution or use of alcoholic beverages in the Exposition area is prohibited without the express prior written approval of *TSN*.

14. Flammable Materials

No flammable fluids or materials of any nature, including decorative materials, use of which is prohibited by national, state, or city fire regulations may be used in any table top space.

15. Lotteries or Contests

The operation of games of chance or lottery devices, or the actual or simulated pursuit of any recreational past time is permitted only on written approval from *TSN*.

16. Noise and Odors

Noisy or obstructive work will not be permitted during open hours of the Exposition/Competition, nor will noisily operating displays, nor exhibits producing objectionable odors. *TSN* shall have sole discretion in determining what is noisy, obstructive or objectionable.

17. Music

Any exhibitor using music must ensure that licensing fees have been paid to the appropriate agency, i.e., ASCAP or BMI. *TSN* is not responsible for any licensing fees for music played in exhibitor's/competitors table top space.

18. Obstruction of Aisles or Table Tops

Any demonstration or activity that results in excessive obstruction of aisles or prevents ready access to nearby exhibitor's booth shall be suspended for any periods specified by *TSN*.

19. Attendance

Admission policies shall remain, at all times, the prerogative of *TSN*, and may be revised or amended to suit unforeseen conditions.

20. Table Top Personnel

Exhibitor/Competitor representatives are restricted to personnel engaged in the display, demonstration, application or sale of the company's product or services. Table top personnel shall wear "exhibitor" badge identification in the exhibit/competition area. All other employees and representatives of the exhibiting/competing companies must register as Show attendees. *TSN* reserves the right to restrict or limit the number of table top representatives. All exhibits must have personnel present during show hours.

21. Height and Non-Blocking Regulations

All exhibit/competition display construction design must conform to the regulations set forth in the "Display Rules and Regulations," a copy of which is supplied to each exhibitor by *TSN*. "Display Rules and Regulations" provides details as to what is allowed for exhibitor's booth so as to enable use of the space without detriment to neighboring exhibitors or the Exposition.

22. Electrical Safety

All wiring on booths or display fixtures must meet underwriters' rules and standard fire department inspection. This applies to booth construction only and not to pre-wired radio and electronic equipment.

23. Use of Space

Displays and demonstrations are limited to the confines of an exhibitor's/competitors own table top, as is the distribution of literature or other items.

24. Display

TSN shall have full authority for approval or arrangement and appearance of items displayed. *TSN* may, at its discretion, require replacement, rearrangement, or redecoration of any item or any tabletop or booth, and no liability shall attach to *TSN* for the costs that may evolve upon exhibitor/competitor thereby. Exhibitors/Competitors with special backgrounds or side dividers must make certain that such material is furnished in such a manner as to not be unsightly to exhibitors in adjoining table tops. If such surfaces remain unfinished at 2pm of the day of the scheduled opening of the show, *TSN* shall authorize the official decorator to effect the necessary finish and the exhibitor/competitor must pay all charges involved thereby.

25. Exhibitor Representative's Responsibility

In addition, Exhibitor/Competitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless *TSN*, its directors, officers, agents, representatives and employees, attendees and other exhibitor/competitors, from and against any and all liabilities, claims, injuries, expenses (including attorneys fees), costs, obligations and damages of any kind related to or arising out of the use or occupancy of its exhibit space.

26. Waiver of Rights

Any rights of *TSN* under this contract shall not be deemed waived in any manner except as specifically waived in writing and signed by an authorized officer of *TSN*.

27. Relocation and Floor Plan Revisions

TSN retains the exclusive right to revise the exhibition hall floor plan and/or move assigned exhibitors/competitors as necessary.

28. Amendment and Addition Rules

Any matters not specifically covered by the preceding rules shall be subject solely to the decision of *TSN*. *TSN* may, at any time, amend or add further rules to these rules, and all amendments made shall be binding on exhibitor/competitor equally with the foregoing rules and regulations.

29. Agreement to Rules

Exhibitor/Competitor, for himself or itself, his or its personnel, employees, agents or representatives, agrees to abide by the foregoing rules and those provided and contained in the Exhibitors/Competitor Manual, and by any amendments and additional rules that may be put into effect by *TSN*.
